The CiC Program, MJIIT Global Mobility Program and Shibaura Global Mobility Program will be presented by a representative from University of Tsukuba

(Japan), YBhg. Prof. Datin Dr Rubiyah Yusof (Dean of MJIIT) and a representative from Shibaura Institute of Technology (Japan). The launching ceremony will be announced by YB Dato' Seri Idris Jusoh, Minister of Higher Education.
